The rod fishery regulations are as follows:

Salmon

- Fishing season from 1st March to 30th September inclusive.
- Use of shrimp, prawn, worm or maggot, real or imitation, is prohibited at all times.
- Use of spinners is prohibited after 31st March.
- No salmon to be retained before 16th June.
- No salmon greater than 70cms to be retained after 31st July.
- The following bag limits for salmon apply after 16th June:
 - 2 fish in any 24-hour period.
 - 3 fish in any 7-day period.
 - 10 fish in a season.

Sea Trout:

- Fishing Season: 15th March – 30th September
- The following bag limits for sea-trout apply:
 - 5 fish in any 24-hour period.
 - 15 fish in any 7-day period.
 - 40 fish in a season.

No rod caught salmon or sea trout may be sold or offered for sale.
